30 ancestors over 7 generations of Comm Gerhard are known.

The numbering system used is known as the Eytzinger- or Sosa-Stradonitz-Method. The subject (proband), here Comm Gerhard, of the ancestor table (Ahnentafel) is listed as No. 1, the subject's father as No. 2 and the mother as No. 3, the paternal grandparents as No. 4 and No. 5 and the maternal grandparents as No. 6 and No. 7, and so on, back through the generations. Apart from No. 1, who can be male or female, all even-numbered persons are male, and all odd-numbered persons are female. In this schema, the number

of any person's father is double the person's number ($2 \cdot n$), and a person's mother is double the person's number plus one ($2 \cdot n + 1$).

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
